

Connecticut Hang-A-Quilt

Banner Instructions

- Signs need to be placed near your quilt and will be both visible and readable from the road. Be sure to clearly state these 3 lines: Connecticut Hang-a-Quilt Day , #CTHangAQuiltDay ,and fvquilter.org
- Use up some of your orphan blocks and some scraps to decorate the sign by fusing them to the background and topstitching them.
- A good size for your sign is about 24" x 27" , but surely use your discretion here.
- You may want to use a garden banner holder or nail it to a tree or any other creative ways you want to display it.
- Enjoying the process? Why not make one for a friend or two or for other members who might like one? Meet or Zoom with a few friends and make some together!
- Another option is to purchase a ready-made yard sign from guild member Barb Aubin of Signs Plus for \$10 each. These signs are made of corrugated plastic and are reusable year after year. If you are interested in purchasing contact Barb at linic@comcast.net
